a certain lot of land situated on Orrs Island in said Hamps well, it being the same where the said Meeting house now stands and bounded as follows, East southerly, by land of David Orr, from the gate on the road six rods, thence South Westerly by land of William Orr, three rods ten links, thence west Northerly, by land of William Orr, five rods eight links, thence North easterly by the road, four rods eight links to the first mentioned bounds, containing six thousand two hundred and seventy two square feet more or less
